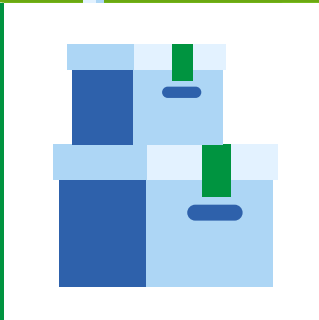
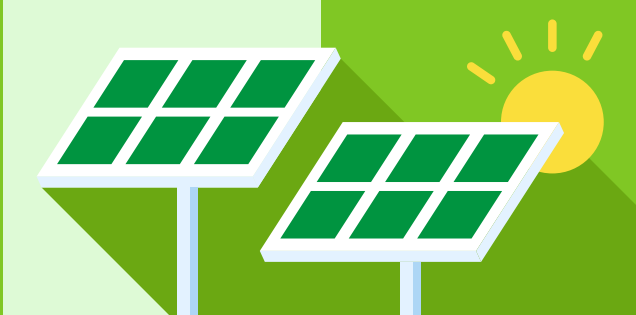

# 1 What's changing?

Starting from **March 31<sup>st</sup> 2025**, new laws concerning dry recycling and food waste will take effect across England.

These changes aim to:

- End confusion about what can and can't be recycled.
- Reduce landfill waste.
- Standardise recycling practices for homes, schools and workplaces.

**Separate dry recyclables from general waste**



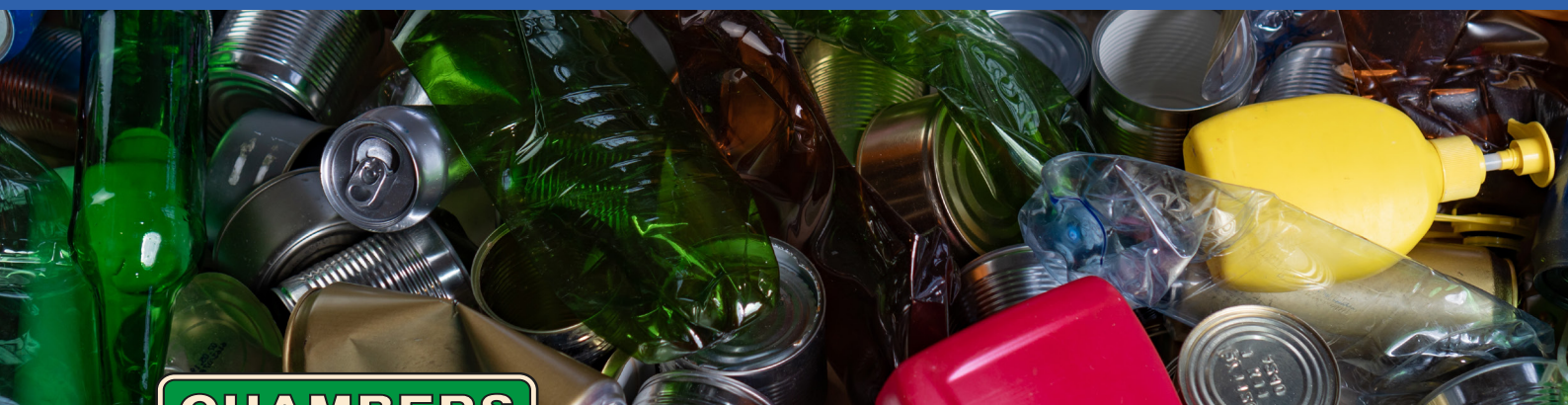
**Separate food waste from general waste**



Don't worry - this doesn't mean you need individual bins for each type of material.

The key is to ensure these materials are not mixed with general waste.

Glass jars and bottles will also need to be separated from general waste.
